Meals are chosen prior to the day, at home with parents via School Grid – really important that meals are chosen before the day otherwise your child will only have the very limited option of a jacket potato.

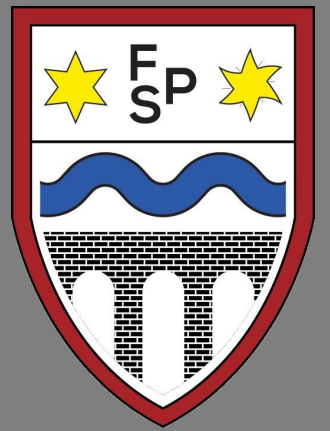
We cater for all dietary requirements, including a halal option.

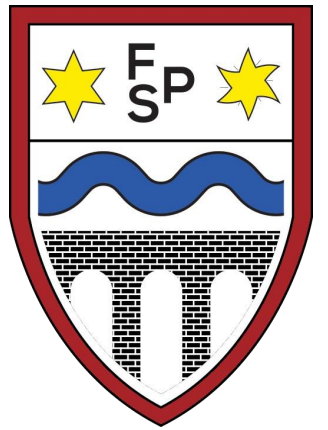
Grey skirt or pinafore dress, grey school cardigan or jumper (as above) over a red polo T-shirt and white or grey socks or grey tights.

PE kit should be sent into school each Monday.



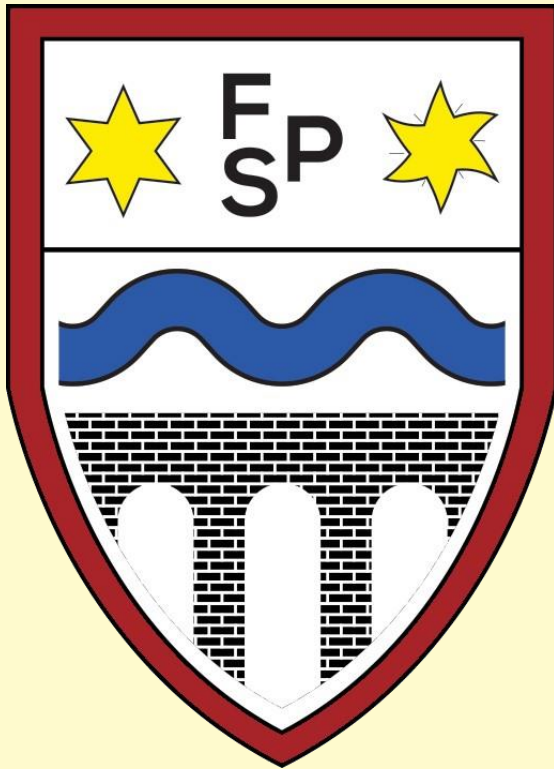
# Homework in Year 2

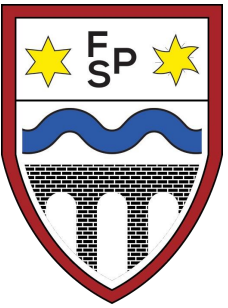

# How will you let me know how my child is doing throughout the year?

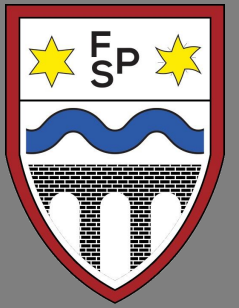


There are 4 key ways in which we will keep you informed of how your child is doing during the year:

1. Sharing the curriculum and lesson content with you
2. Via parents' evenings and via the summer term school report.
3. By sharing assessment information with you (started in 2022 – 2023)
4. Through informal communication at the doors and via phone or Arbor emails when needed.

Parents of children with additional needs have an extra x2 contact points with class teachers (minimum) throughout the year to review targets on Provision Map.

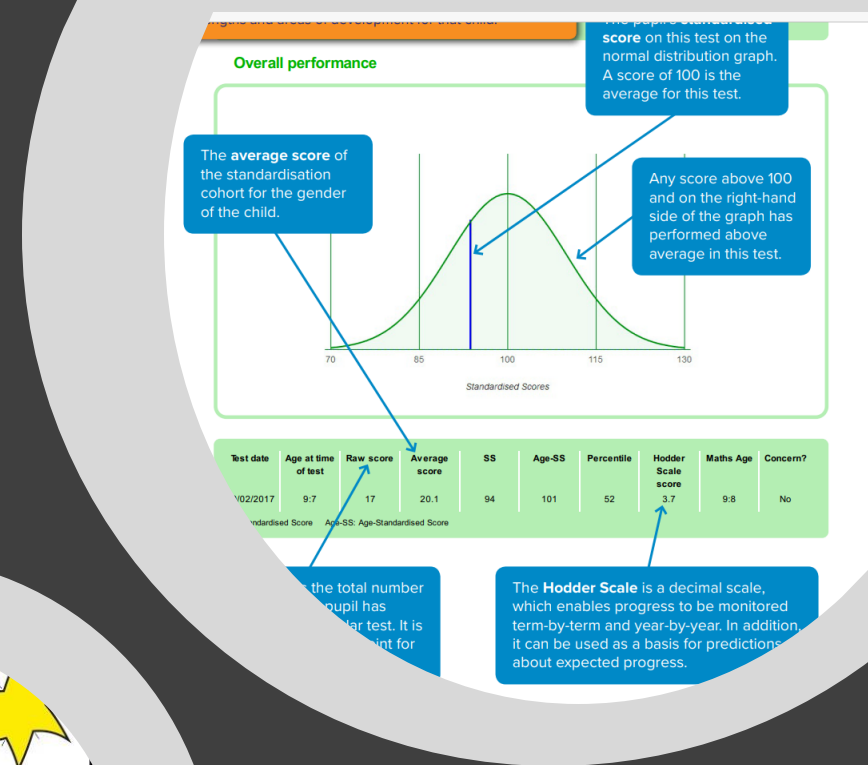


# 3. Assessment Weeks

Assessments are a key tool in finding out what strengths children have and what areas they need to develop further.

Assessments help to identify gaps in knowledge so that teachers can plan their future lessons. For example, if a whole class is struggling on the "fractions" element of maths, more lessons will focus on this. If all the class score well on times table questions, less time needs to be given to this.

Our internal assessments are "low stakes" and we approach them positively with the children.

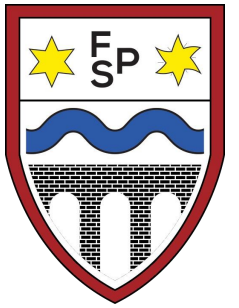

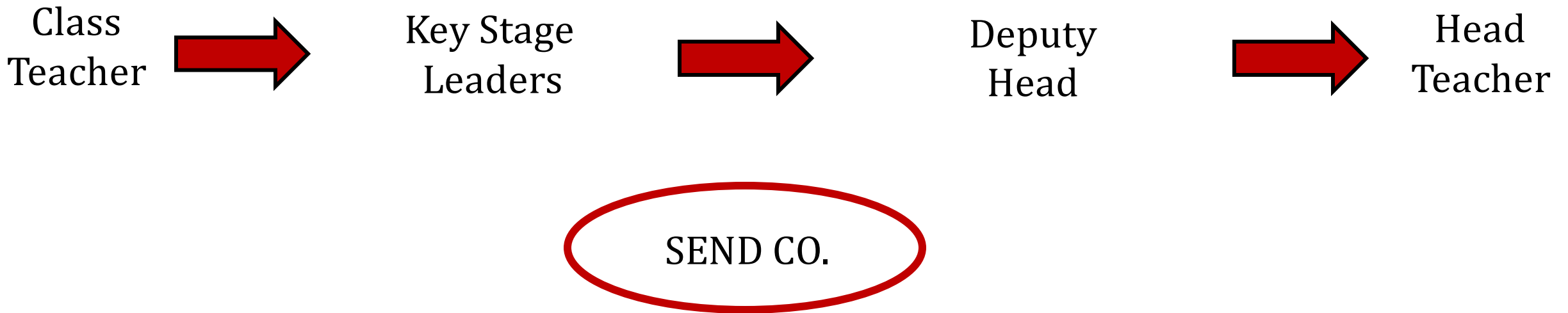

# Celebrating Success



There are many ways in which we celebrate success at Feniscowles!

# Celebrating Success



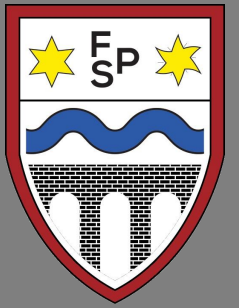
Dojo points are also used as 'House Points'. Each week, the school's house points are added up from EYFS to Year 6 and the overall winner is announced in assembly.

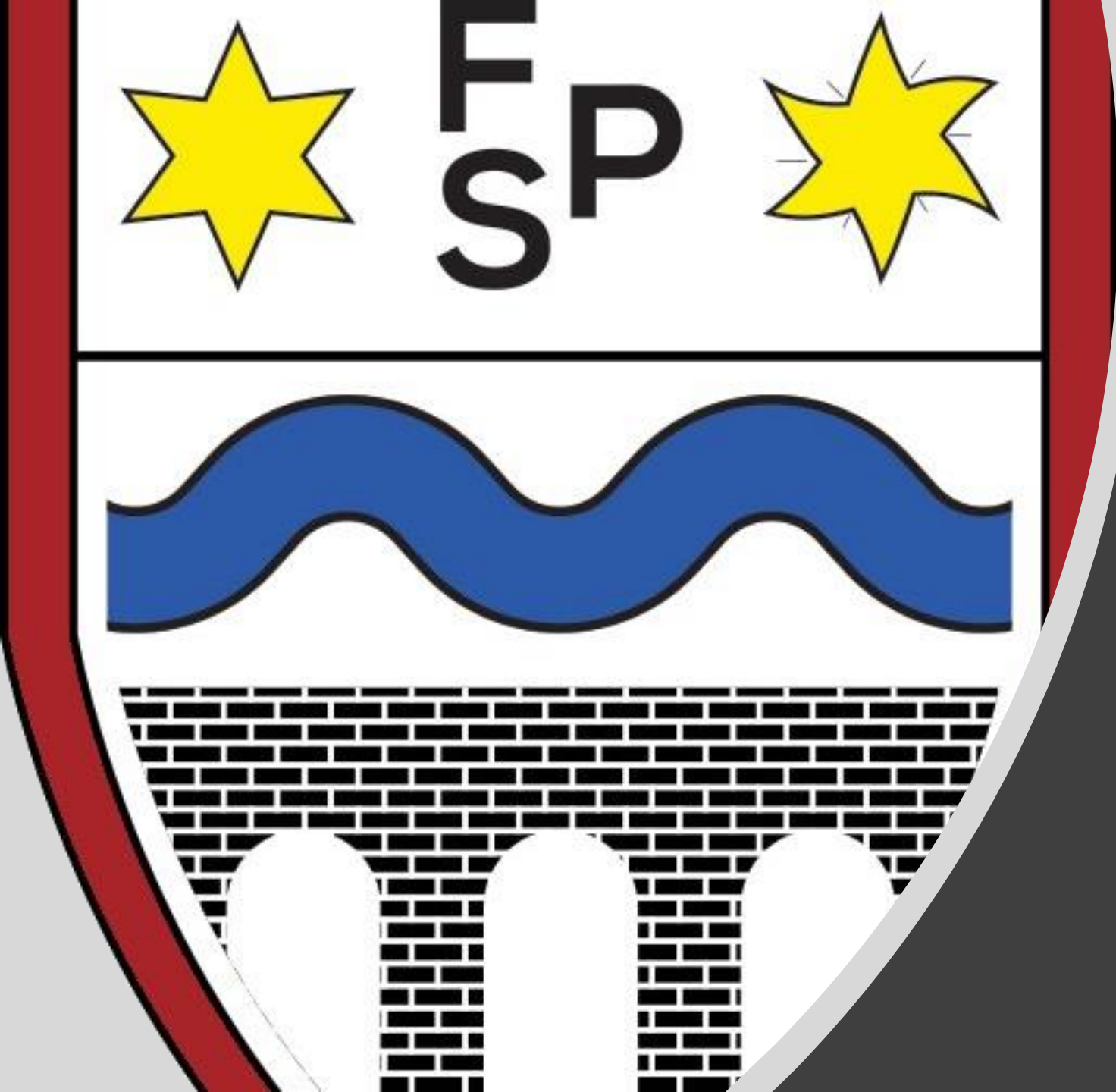
